On July 26, 2018, Administrative Law Judge Clark S. Cheney of the United States International Trade Commission (ITC) issued an Initial Determination that Fujifilm's ASPIRE Cristalle mammography system infringes certain Hologic U.S. patents. This decision is preliminary and Fujifilm will request a full review of the Administrative Law Judge Clark S. Cheney's findings.

It is important to note, that at this time, no exclusion order has been issued in the U.S. Fujifilm believes there are strong grounds for the full ITC to decide in Fujifilm's favor when it issues its Final Determination and remains committed to continuing its significant investments in R&D and advancing women's health.
